The Small Business Energy Advance program is available to all Small Business program participants with the following limits and conditions:					
<ol> <li>Customer's account must be in good standing at time of application submission and project completion. Good standing means account does not have an outstanding balance due to late or unpaid bills.</li> </ol>					
2 Participation is limited to three projects per customer concurrently.					
3 Customer Contribution amounts below \$500 are not eligible.					
4. The Advance must be for the full Customer Contribution amount as shown in Section II.					
5 Repayment will be based on a 6, 12 or 24-month term and included as part of the total amount due and payable on the Delmarva Power monthly bill statements for the electric account number shown in Section I, Customer Information.					
<b>6</b> The Customer Contribution and Delmarva Power Contribution amounts will be paid by Delmarva Power as directed by the customer per the Terms and Conditions. The customer may opt to receive both amounts or assign to the installation contractor or a third party.					
7. Small Business Energy Advance participants are subject to all Terms & Conditions of the Small Business program as shown on the controlling Small Business Program Participation Agreement. Customer must sign both Small Business program and Small Business Energy Advance Participation Agreements. Customer eligibility is defined as an active commercial account in service for at least 12 months based in the Delmarva Power Maryland territory. The account must exhibit demand of 100 kW or less over the previous 12 months to be eligible for the Small Business program.
